Scholarship Application Requirements

- Currently a senior attending a public, private or parochial high school located in Bell or Coryell County
- Complete Scholarship Application
- Provide two letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation should not be from a family member.
 1. One letter of recommendation from a *High School* scholastic staff or faculty member (Principal, Assistant Principal, Counselor, Teacher, etc.)
 2. One letter of recommendation from a community member (Minister, Employer, etc. that is not a scholastic or faculty member)
- An official high school transcript. The transcript should be stamped, sealed or signed by your school's registrar.
- Provide signed documentation of community service hours for the time period of January 1, 2023 – February 28, 2026. Documentation should include location, date, description of service, amount of service time and signature of adult sponsor



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- Write an essay.
 1. The essay must be 500-750 words, typed, double spaced, 12-point font and Times New Roman font face.
 2. Essay cover sheet should include your name, name your high school and essay topic
- Essay Topics – please select one
 1. How do you define community service, and why is it important to you? Describe your past involvement in service and how you intend to remain engaged as you pursue higher education?
 2. Many ideas and inventions from over a century ago still shape our daily lives. Select one such innovation and discuss its enduring impact, including how it has affected you personally.
 3. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
 4. Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?

Student Guidelines for Using AI in Writing Scholarship Essays

We recognize that some applicants will use AI tools. For those who do, we encourage AI to be used wisely and ethically to ensure your work remains authentic and personal. It's also important to know that there are risks and drawbacks, including the lack of personal touch and plagiarism. Here are some guidelines for using AI:

- Use AI to Support, Not Substitute: AI should be used to assist you in the writing process, not to write the essay for you. Use AI for brainstorming, grammar checks, structural suggestions, and feedback, but ensure the core ideas and content are your own.
- Avoiding Plagiarism: Always start with your own ideas and experiences. Use AI to refine and polish your writing but avoid copying text generated by AI word for word.
- Share Your Story: AI can tell general or generic stories, but it cannot tell your story. Scholarship committees are human and want to hear about your unique experiences, challenges, and aspirations. Illustrate your points with specific examples from your life using your own voice. This makes your essay more engaging and relatable.
- Review AI Suggestions: Carefully review any changes or suggestions made by AI to ensure they align with your voice and message. Adjust as needed to maintain your personal touch, and don't let it overshadow your ideas.
- Proofread: After using AI tools, thoroughly proofread your essay to ensure it reads naturally and authentically.
- Seek Human Feedback: In addition to AI, seek feedback from teachers, mentors, or peers. Human perspectives can provide valuable insights that AI might miss.

If you follow these guidelines, you can effectively use AI to enhance your scholarship essay, ensuring it reflects your personal experiences and aspirations. Below are additional resources you can reference in using AI ethically and effectively.
